KINDERGARTEN LEVIES

A levy of \$130.00 is payable to the office during Uniform Sales or on the day your child commences school.

Levies may be paid in installments. Please discuss with the School Business Manager.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

When you bring your child to Kindergarten, come inside and say hello. This gives us the opportunity to discuss your child's time at Kindergarten.

If there is to be a different person from normal collecting your child from Kindergarten, it is vital that you let us know.

FOOD AND DRINK

East Tamar Primary School is making a genuine attempt to be a **Nut Aware and Egg Aware** school in response to the serious allergic reactions some of our students may experience when they come into contact with either of these products. We ask for your support in not sending food to school that contain nuts/nut products or egg/egg products.

Morning Tea – Children are encouraged to have a piece of fruit, e.g. watermelon, strawberries, blueberries, banana, apple. As fruit will not be shared, please cut for them if necessary.

Lunch – Please provide a sandwich, bread roll, wrap or rice cakes. Please also provide one or two snacks from the items below.

- Yoghurt
- Fruit
- Dried fruits

- Cheese and crackers
- Celery sticks
- Carrot sticks



Water is the drink of choice for our school.

As lollies and chocolate contain many allergens please keep these for 'AT HOME' treats.

HEALTH AND ABSENCE

If your child is sick he/she should stay home until fully recovered. Children cannot enjoy their time at Kindergarten if not 100% well, on medication or unable to go outside to play. If the cause of the sickness is an infectious disease, call and see us at school and we will tell you how long the regulations state your child must be away.

Please tell us if your child will be away for any reason as absences have to be recorded daily and are monitored by the Education Department. We have a free school app where you can notify us of any absences.

REQUIREMENTS

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL OF YOUR CHILD'S POSSESSIONS ARE CLEARLY NAMED.

Each child will need:

- \Box A broad brimmed hat (available from the office)
- \Box A school bag
- □ A library bag (one library bag is supplied to each Kinder student)

□ A change of clothes, to be kept in their school bag if your child tends to have 'accidents'.

USEFUL THINGS FOR YOUR CHILD TO KNOW

Knowing how to do the following things independently will help your child to cope more successfully in a new situation, and feel more confident about school:

- \Box How to use toilet and wash hands
- $\hfill\square$ Put on and take off jumper
- \Box Put on and take off shoes
- \Box Use a handkerchief or tissue to blow own nose
- □ Unwrap food (from plastic wrap)
- \Box Undo and do up drink bottle, lunch box
- \Box Recognise own name
- \Box Able to rub on sunscreen
- \Box Zip up bag



CLOTHING

We strongly encourage and promote the wearing of school uniforms.

We will do our best to protect your child's clothes. When they paint they will wear a smock. However, it is not possible for children to stay clean at all times. New school uniforms are available at the office throughout the year and on Uniform Sales Days.

Children must wear a broad brimmed or legionnaire hat (not a cap) when they are playing outside, and appropriate footwear. The wearing of hats is compulsory in Term I and Term 4.

LIBRARY

Your child will be encouraged to borrow a book from the library on a regular basis during their library lesson time. We will let you know which day early in Term 1. If a book is lost or damaged an

account will be sent to the parents/guardians for the replacement cost of the book.

All Kinder children are given a Library Bag at the beginning of the year.

Children will need to bring their library book bag in order to be able to borrow a book.

CANTEEN

Children are able to order lunch from the School Canteen. This can be done via the School Canteen App Qkr before school. Children are not able to visit the canteen during break times.

Please note: icy poles are not available to Kinder students.

NEWSLETTER

The school newsletter is distributed to the eldest child in the family every second Wednesday. The newsletter includes details of school activities and notices of a general nature.

NO SMOKING

The whole school is a "Smoke Free Zone", i.e. no smoking at all within the buildings or grounds, or within 100 metres of the entrances.







SCHOOL APP

The school has a free app where you may advise us of absences or any changes to student details. A calendar of events, school notices and the newsletter are also available. Download it now to your smartphone by going to either the Apple App Store or Android Google Play Market and search for East Tamar Primary School.



SUPPORTING STUDENTS

ETPS has a number of staff who can help student and families with particular needs. Our professional support staff include: A Speech and Language Pathologist, Social Worker, Psychologist, Occupational Therapist, School Nurse and a Chaplain.
